Parking Policy



Introduction

The safety of the students, staff and visitors on our school site is of the highest priority.

Parking on our school site is a privilege, which is dependent on the driver's compliance with this policy.

Purpose

The purpose of this Policy is to:

- provide safe access to school for all pedestrians
- provide an orderly arrangement for parking of vehicles on the school site
- acknowledge that parking on the school site, which is private property, is a privilege and not a right.

Scope

This Policy applies to all staff, volunteers and contractors at the College.

Principles

1. Speed

- All vehicles are required to comply with an appropriate speed restriction. As a guide, vehicles should be moving at approximately 20kms per hour (slower if deemed necessary).
- This is vital as many students and staff are on the site.

2. Traffic Flow

Kildare Campus:

• Enter and exit Kosciuszko Street with caution.

St Paul's Campus:

- Pick up and drop off in service lane in Grey Street.
- Staff entrance eastern gates along Grey Street.

3. Parking

Student Pick Up & Drop Off Zone:

- Kildare Campus parking along Kosciuszko Street or Pick Up / Drop Off Bay located on the Kildare Campus grounds.
- St Paul's Campus service road in Grey Street or Grubb Avenue only.

Staff Car Parking:

- Kildare Campus either along Kosciuszko Street or designated car parking on school grounds. These areas are marked for your convenience.
- St Paul's Campus either along the service road or designated staff car parking on the premises. These areas are marked for your convenience.

Students:

- No parking on College premises.
- Do not park in such a way as to obstruct other vehicles from leaving their bays.
- 4. All staff directives are to be complied with immediately for the safety and convenience of all.
- 5. All signs and line markings are to be complied with.
 - a. Signs are self-evident
 - b. Yellow solid lines are no standing zones
- 6. Failure to comply with this policy may result in the privilege of parking on the school site being withdrawn. The school site is private property.

7. Damage to motor vehicles

- a. In line with insurance recommendations, damage to vehicles parked on school grounds is not covered by the College, you will park at your own risk. The following times apply:
 - Parking in business hours
 - Outside of business hours
 - Weekends / non-school days
- b. Damage deemed the fault of the College will be covered:
 - Mower, machinery equipment
 - Official College motor vehicle
 - Damage caused by a student's actions will be the responsibility of the student and his or her family.
 The College will assist in mediation only.
- 8. It is recommended that all staff have the appropriate insurance cover.
