Please note:

- Forms received after 13th August, will be treated as late and the student's subject selections will be initially removed from the "Timetabler" import process.
- Every effort is made to assign student preferences in each semester. Enrolment in your subject choices is conditional upon class sizes, staff expertise and available facilities.
- Year 11 students are given preference to Unit 1 & 2 VCE and VET units, so a Year 10 student's enrolment at this level is dependent upon class numbers.
- The College timetable is designed based on initial student choices. It should not be assumed that changes to a student's subject selection can be made later, as limitations may exist in the timetable.
